**Record notes of Discussion of 9th Meeting of
'Energy accounting committee of Intra-State ABT'
Held on dated 21st APRIL-2011 at GETRI, Vadodara.**

Date : 21st April-2011
Place : GETRI, Vadodara.

Subject : Energy Accounting Committee Meeting.

Ninth meeting of Energy Accounting Committee was held at GETRI conference hall, Vadodara on 21st April-2011. for reviewing State energy Account (SEA) as well as weekly energy accounts prepared under intra-state ABT regime. List of the Participants is attached herewith at Annexure.

The agenda points of the meeting were to review the membership of existing energy accounting committee (formation of new committee), sharing of experience of intra-state ABT in the state, discussion on introduction of congestion charges.

The Chief Engineer (SLDC) welcomed all the participants in the meeting. He briefly stated the points to be covered in the meeting. He opined to have active participation of each member to make intra-state ABT regime fruitful. Status of intra-state ABT accounts was appraised among all participants.

- Total UI accounts issued as on the date of meeting up to 49th Week i.e. up to the week ending by 13.03.2011
- Based on the feedback received from beneficiaries, UI accounts are being revised up to 2nd May 2010 and remaining are under process.
- UI account settled up to 46th week.
- Provisional SEA issued for the March 2011.
- Final SEA account issued up to July 2010.

There after he directed coordinator officer to take of agenda item for discussion.

AGENDA NO. 1 : Review of Energy accounting committee meeting structure:

In the brief presentation following points were covered/explained.

All committee members/participants are requested to check/verify the accounts prepared by SLDC. In case of any mistake/omission detected, it shall be rectified.

It was envisaged to arrange this meeting at regular interval. It was decided to arrange this meeting in the last week of every month.

Representative of M/s GPEC has expressed that, he has to apprise his higher management regarding membership/responsibility in the committee. It was informed that, at present, name of M/s GPEC is suggested as the committee member, in case of any apprehension, M/s GPEC may represent separately.

Among the intra-state entities, M/s APL and M/s TPL-SUGEN are categorized under UMPP category. Presently, this category is not defined in clause no. 15 (d) of GERC order no 3 of 2006 and amendment thereof. Regarding participation of above generators in the committee formation, it is decided to refer the matter before the Hon'ble commission.

AGENDA NO. 2 : Experience of Intra-state ABT in the state.

Coordinator appreciated active participation of all the entities for successful implementation of intra-state ABT in the state. From the experience of one year of implementation it was felt by SLDC to elaborate various provisions regarding scheduling methodology in case of grid disturbance or transmission constraint.

Clause no 5.12 & 5.13 of ANNEXURE-III (scheduling and dispatch code) of GERC order No 3 of 2010 was explained in detail with quoting recent event of grid disturbance. Action to be taken by the generator explained as under

- Generator injection schedule shall be ZERO (in case of tripping of all the unit(s),) till the constraint persists.
- In case of survival of any unit of the affected generating station, Generating station shall declare its capability with survived units. Injection schedule shall be prepared accordingly.
- Original DC (before the constraint occurred) shall remain unaltered.
- On removal of constraint (as certified by SLDC) prior to synchronization of units, generating station shall require to give its ramp schedule.
- On clearance from SLDC, unit have to be synchronized within reasonable time.
- No post ramp schedule shall be allowed. In case of non receipt of the ramp schedule, it shall be scheduled as per the detail available at SLDC.
- During the mean time, if any problem observed in generator availability, DC shall Have to be revised immediately.

Frequent revisions:

- Clause no 5.14 & 5.16 of ANNEXURE-III (scheduling and dispatch code) of GERC Order no. 3 of 2010 was explained.
- As per the above clause, revision shall be advised in case of contingency only.
- It was explained how increase in numbers of revisions affects the scheduling activities at SLDC.
- Some examples of reasons for revision were discussed. All entities Were requested to advice the revision only in case of contingency only and co-operate SLDC. All members were agreed and have assured to make revisions in case of contingency only.

AGENDA NO. 3: Congestion charges:

CERC regulation on congestion charges was explained. Following points were discussed.

- Real time congestion management- Reason for consideration of congestion.
- Applicability of congestion charge
- Congestion charge-Accounting and settlement
- Declaration of congestion charge.

NLDC has declared congestion to WR constituents for date 26.01.11 and 27.01.11, SLDC shall have to prepare congestion charges account for intra-state utility as per CERC regulation. Methodology for this shall be proposed by SLDC before passing on these congestion charges at intra-state level. The proposed methodology shall be put before Hon'ble commission. Decision in the matter shall be finalized after guideline received from the Hon'ble commission.

Bank guarantee: letter of Credit

As per the clause no 16 (j) of GERC order no 3 of 2006, SLDC may insist on appropriate payment security mechanism by way of bank guarantee equal to seven day billing for scheduled energy either payable or receivable. This BG is required for settlement of UI charges, RE charges and SLDC fees and charges etc.

At present SLDC insist BG for STOA users only. Looking to the large no of participants, and for better and secured payment mechanism (back to back commercial settlement) it is envisaged to insist BG from all intra-state users over and above existing BG mechanism. After detailed deliberation in the matter, to start with, it is envisaged to insist BG from the defaulters.

It was also discussed regarding, working out interest @ 0.04% per day on delay payment on UI charges by the Intra-State entities. It is informed that SLDC will work out interest on delay payment after completion of all UI accounts for FY 10-11.

With the permission of the chair, time frame of issue of SEA is discussed.

M/s APL has suggested to issue provisional SEA up to the end of 1st week (after provisional REA issued by WRPC). SLDC stated that, data of wind farms are required to be incorporated in SEA. These data are provided by GEDA and they are able to finalize these data on about 15th day of the month. In view of this SLDC issues provisional SEA on 17th/18th day of the month. M/s APL and GIPCL opined that, provisional SEA may be prepared and issued without incorporation of wind farm data. Also they added that, this would be very much helpful to them to raise the invoice and settle the accounts for the month. It was opined by the participants to refer this matter to Hon'ble commission.

Meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
